

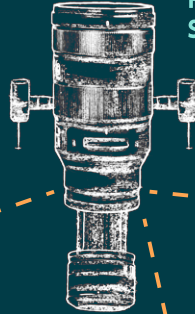

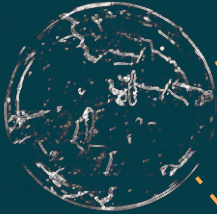

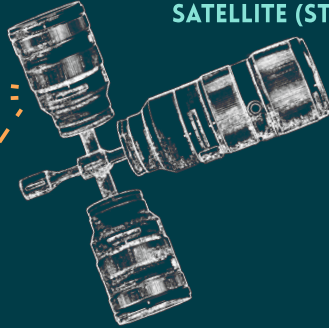

# A BOOK OF SEEDS

[3.1]

■ **MADE TO FIT IN ANY UNIVERSE:** NPCs in this book are supposed to have interesting **professions that are necessary for any future world.** There will be wealth that obsesses over found artifacts across the universe and there will be adventurers who come across ancient xenotech they have no idea how to use. Therefore, there must be specialists who provide services to solve these issues.

These characters are designed to work independent of their setting and plopped into any other space station or planet. Please use a single sentence or the entire book for your home games.

■ **THE SEEDS:** This is a passion project inspired by Chris McDowell's work on Electric Bastionland and Sean McCoy's + TKG's work in the Mothership modules. They provide subtle settings. They bake in assumptions and favor lore + flavor over canon. This is what Familiar Faces aspires to do.

The seeds are scattered in the NPCs' acquaintances and motivations. Many of these seeds won't be watered during future issues, but we hope there ends up being hundreds of versions of the Laughing Sphinx Corporation, Uruk 1, and Eudaimonia.

■ **WEAVING TOGETHER THE SPICY TUNA UNIVERSE:** Familiar Faces is designed to connect Spicy Tuna's other zines. Volume 1 has connections to Knights of Lazarus and the upcoming Incorporated Vol.1 zines. In some ways the professions inside of Familiar Faces Vol.1 were inspired by Spicy Tuna's other zines.

We have provided connections to other products so wardens can easily tie adventures together in their ongoing campaigns or keep familiar elements for players through smaller session games.

We did not include these connections to limit use or require additional purchases. For example, despite the connection to Adonna Camsal from the Yucatan Tech Co, a warden does not need to purchase any additional products to successfully use her in a storyline. Adonna can be used as any other seed in the book without additional information about Yucatan Tech Co.

# 5 WAYS TO USE THIS MODULE

[4.1]

## 1. Home Base for Shore Leave

The **Julip IV System** can be as restoring or dangerous as a warden wants to make it.

It offers players a sandbox of opportunities, shore leave experiences, local conflicts, and mission seeds.

## 2. Piecemeal into your campaign.

Modularly pull people, places, or things into existing campaigns as needed.

## 3. One-Shot Trove

Suggestions

- Explore **Atlas Roe [12.1]** in search of a specific **bunker [15.1]**. Once the crew finds it, the contents will guide the second half of the adventure. Use the **Enforcer Table [14.1]** to intensify the danger.
- Navigate **political conflict [Page 11] on Julip IV [9.1]**. Use the **Julip IV Notables [9.2]** to fill out who the crew can interact with or search for. Optionally use **Gan Bataa's Motivations [20.3]** or intertwine the politics of **Uruk 1 [45.2]** into the adventure.
- Follow any **Storyline from [5.1]**.
- Take a job from any of the Major NPCs from one of the **Possible Contracts [7.1]**.
- Use any Major NPC and their profession as inspiration for an adventure. **[19.1],[23.1],[31.1],[35.1],[39.1],[43.1]**.

## 4. Follow a Storyline [5.1]

Storylines provide optional ways to introduce major NPCs. They progress over 5 events.

They can be used in two ways.

- a. As individual adventures,
- b. Dangerous happenings to spice up shore leave.

### Guidelines to run storylines as dangerous happenings on shore leave:

before running a storyline, allow players time to get to know at least one location in this book, run a single storyline at a time, and space them out to give players opportunity to utilize shore leave.

## 5. Build an adventure around Possible Contracts [7.1]

Contracts give context to what major NPCs are currently working on.

**Contracts can be used as a whole or deconstructed into stand alone parts.** For example, wardens may be more interested in using skitter leeches as an adversary than using the full exhibition contract for Kurt Pharaoh.

Wardens can use the **"Need to Hire"** section to craft an entire adventure around and give reason to building relationships with the NPCs.

# STORYLINES

[5.1]

## Julip IV [9.1]

### Storyline Synopses

#### Risomania Horror Infection:

Without the rest of The Slant Initiative [11.2] knowing, Sutton Song [9.2] has decided to expedite Julip IV's pivot into manufacturing by hiring the bioterrorist group, Imaginaria [45.3]. Things don't go according to plan.

#### Attack on Gilgamesh Red.

A calculated plan of attack results in OmBreaker Mobile Suits stolen from Mansur Jaziri's Hidden Workshop [28.5] as they are used to raid Ainsley Blackwood's Xenotech Restoration Studio [26.1].

#### Hidden Person's Inc Data Breach.

Zoya Amari [23.1] is discovered as the former hacker, Red Bird, that was thought to have brought down the Grey Terror Cartel [45.4]. They now seek revenge.

### Time Between Events

Always time events to the playstyle of your group. For investigative tables, an event may happen once a session. For quick-paced reactive groups, the events may happen every 40 minutes over the course of a one-shot.

#### Risomania Horror Infection

**Sutton Song [9.2] hires Imaginaria [46.1], a bioterrorist corp to infect 20% of Julip IV's crop.**

Imaginaria imports **Risomania Horrors** into Julip IV's Southern hemisphere which infect the crop.

**Hagatha Labs** identifies the horrors. **Consumption of crop causes hallucinations. Body Save at Disadvantage.**

Cases increase. **Julip IV halts all exports and passenger travel.**

**Determination of sabotage** is established. **Food shortage warnings hit all Julip IV Satellites [12.1],[25.1],[45.2].**

**Julip Cardinal Police preemptively arrest all minority politicians and visitors.**

3

**Food Supplies:** Uruk 1 at 70 days. Atlas Roe at 30 days. Gilgamesh Red at 24 days.

**Uruk 1 sends demands for Julip IV to share their crops and resume exports.**

**Julip IV Satellites restrict food supplies to non-citizens.**

4

**Sutton Song is arrested.**

2 days later a **mercenary blockade forms 35km from the Julip IV Satellites** declaring they **will attack any ships coming in or out of the blockade.**

## Gilgamesh Red [25.1]

### Attack on Gilgamesh Red

**Docks shut down for new landings for the next 48 hours due to overparking.**

"Gilgamesh Red has entered capacity. We ask all non-owners to depart the station."

**Security cameras across the station glitch.** GR Cybersecurity team is unable to reverse.

GR Cybersecurity enlist **Water Hose Inc. [27.6]** for assistance.

**Stabilized after 40min.**

**Station security prioritizes bunkering Ainsley Blackwood's Studio [26.1], Mansur Jaziri's Workshop [28.5], Weapons Wing [27.3], and Station Supports [27.2], [28.2].**

Visitors quarantined in the **Sit Down District [26.4].**

## Atlas Roe [12.1]

### Hidden Persons Inc Data Breach

**Coordinated EMP bombs detonated in all populated areas of 200+ people on Atlas Roe.**

Grey Terror snipers and search parties land on two desolate areas on the moon.

"This is Rixon Barbara of the **Grey Terror Cartel [46.2]. We are here to extract Ayana, also known as Red Bird, or Zoya Amari [23.1]. Departing ships will be destroyed.**

Cooperation is best."

**Hidden Persons Inc [12.1]** has notified and confirmed contact with all hidden persons on Atlas Roe.

Casualties increase, prisoners taken and used to sniff out Zoya Amari.

# JULIP IV

[9.1]

Planet

Julip IV was settled 643 years ago by inhabitants of the **Zadari Solar System**. Prior to landing, there was no intelligent life on the planet. The **natural terrestrial fauna lacks diversity**, comprising mostly of amphibians, smaller reptiles, and a few avian species.

**Julip IV depends on its massive agricultural industry.** The soil is naturally rich and nutrient-dense, and the **government-funded research is largely dedicated to biotechnology.**

Julipians are practitioners of Mendelian genetics, selective breeding of seeds, and regenerative agriculture. They use a variety of techniques including the use of cover crops, seasonal crop rotations, minimal tilling, natural composts, microbial inoculant injections, and genetic engineering to specify growth and nutrient development responses to the unique atmospheric, water, and soil conditions of Julip IV.

**Most produce is immediately powdered, sealed, and processed into nutrient-dense meal supplements for exporting.** The remainder is kept fresh for the local inhabitants.

**All land on the planet is owned by the Julipian Government which is rented through long-term contracts.** Currently, **40% of the land is being farmed.**

The remainder of the land is made up of dense forests, rainforests, and scarce plains. A single desert sits in the southern hemisphere.

**60% of the planet's water is fresh**, most of it stored in underground aquifers. Julip IV has a relatively small ocean, but abundant with fresh water lakes that sit above aquifers.

**Livestock on the planet must be genetically modified** to produce less environmentally impactful gasses such as phosphorus to prevent evaporation of the lakes and a runaway greenhouse effect.

# JULIPIAN IV POLITICAL PARTIES

## THE CROFT PARTY 11.1

- Increase Julipian farmland to 70% of total land use over the next three years. Half of new farmland will be state-ran, increasing high-paying governmental employment and expanding state-owned exports. Decrease local taxes by 85%.
- Increase the gross national income by 80% through the increased farmland initiative.
- High emphasis on the economic relationships with the Julip IV's Satellites.
- Recent Political Wins
  - 60,000 sq km of new privately-ran farmland (converted from forests) dedicated to a financial assistance program aimed at helping citizens whose lineage traces back three generations. Extra tax for use of gov. equipment.
  - Increased emission taxes and heightened regulations on the genetic enhancement requirements for livestock.

## SLANT INITIATIVE 11.2

- Decrease reliance on interplanetary imports of medicine, central processing units, cybernetics, farm equipment, and transportation. At current, dependence presents a potential economic and safety hazard for the planet.
- Quadruple available licenses for manufacturing businesses for the above categories.
- Increase technological output on the planet. They intend to redistribute current R&D funding (currently dominated by agricultural biotechnology).
- To combat increased emissions they plan to invest 100mcr into direct air capture technology.
- Recent Political wins
  - 20% decrease in manufacturing tax for businesses that export less than 40% of their production.
  - Prevented the previous 4 attempts to deprivatize the manufacturing industry.

## THE TRUST PARTY

11.3

- Minimize current government restraints, decrease taxes, and shrink the overall power of the government.
- They believe the government should be economically self-sustaining and run as a corporation whose primary function is a "middleman" between local production and interplanetary trade partners. This will decrease the taxes on the people, increase defense funds, and provide more ecological and agricultural grants.
- Recent Political Wins
  - Started the Department of Economy with elected representatives from each political party. Their first start up provides rehydration systems and maintenance.

# ATLAS ROE

[12.1]

Satellite (Natural)

The only natural satellite of Julip IV [9.1]. All land on Atlas Roe is privately owned by a few hundred individuals. Most own large areas, towns, or subterranean parts of the moon, while a few own small plots, single houses, or other living areas.

The moon is home to several towns and villages - most of which are not neighboring.

The majority of the land is accepted to be "unoccupied".

- **Relatively safe place** to meander, depending on the town's enforcement.
- **UBI covers living expenses.**
- Government paid utilities cap usage for individuals unless they operate a registered export business.

## NOTABLES

- **Husk Cruto:** Head of the Chainmail Street Gang.
- **K. Cola:** "Hidden Person" - Android under protective services for discovering the blackmarket identities in the Zadari Solar System.
- **Nayiga Masiko:** Owns Busia Munyenye, the most populated city and unofficial trade capital on the moon.
- **Guglielmo Marconi:** "Hidden Person" - Radio engineer who gathered intel on the Cells Syndicate during installations and repair jobs.

Hidden Persons Inc uses Atlas Roe as a new home for displaced people hunted by bad actors.

They hold several contracts with the owners of towns and provide people under their protection with stipends for personal expenses exceeding the moon's UBI. They offer additional services that enable their protected persons' self-sufficiency.

The people living under protective services are pulled from a variety of solar systems and, for the most part, are unaware that others under protective services live here.

Atlas Roe is one of many new homes they chose because of the **lack of off-moon trade**. Most of the wealth is held off-moon and the commercially more significant satellites and planets nearby detract interest from Atlas Roe.

# 1D10 II FOUND A BUNKER SPREAD

[15.1]

1 3x weeks of rations. Stacks of funnels and plastic bottles. Oil, paint cans, soap molds. **Adelina Perez**, a woman missing for eight years. **She knows Atlas Roe [12.1] is a safe haven used by Hidden Persons Inc and claims that the agency is actively making people disappear** under false pretenses. She wishes to leave the moon and ruin Hidden Persons Inc.

She is **highly reactionary** and **prone to violence** if threatened. **Quick to take cover** and claims to have the blast shelters rigged with explosives.

2 2x months of rations. An unreadable note stamped vigorously with green ink. Metal racks are loosely built. Bolts of fabric. A pulse rifle. Awful bedding.

**Laser-engraved, non-uniform curved lines texture the walls. If viewed at a distance, 5ft tall fingerprints can be distinguished.** High-quality images of the fingerprints can be run through planet and solar system databases. **4 of the 17 unique fingerprints will pull 2-5 potential matches each on Sentinalis Core** (distant planet in the same solar system as Julip IV).

Only **one name pulls multiple times from the prints: Hank Swisher.**

3 1x month of rations. **Large white linens divide the room into sections. The section in the middle is illuminated by 4x floodlights that make the entire bunker glow. A large pile of ancient coins are scattered across the floor. Beheaded heroic figures are lined against the back wall with 6 vibechetes above them and carefully carved, "Marcello Renato" [35.1] on the wall.**

4 4x months of rations. A collection of records and a record player are pristinely kept in the backroom (20kcr). **Among the records are recordings of the Julipian IV Trust Party [11.3] promising crop subsidies to the royal prince of the Uruk 1 [45.2] mixed government in exchange for endorsement in the upcoming Julip IV elections.**

5 No rations. The floor is bare besides a large white circle surrounding a grated door in the floor. **Pitch black dark tunnel burrows down and to the North.** Inside lives an Emperor Slug (C:50 2d10) I:25 H:3(20), a symbiote that **can flatten itself against a surface and attempts to devour its host's bottom half** with its wide opening mouth full of jagged teeth.

**If attached, the player gains Speed +20 and moves by way of contraction and expansion on mucus.**

- 6 50 gallon vats halfway full of orange acetic worms fill the space. The worms secrete an incredible amount of metal dissolving acid. 400x glass gallon jars. A list of customers including contact information: Mostly waste management and mercenary camps.
- 7 1x week of rations. It's chilly inside. Mirrors of all shapes are hung on the walls. Iron pickers (1d5 dmg) and chrome root shovels (1d5 dmg) are collected in an umbrella stand. A log of future delivery dates is tucked behind the stand. A 4-gallon wax melter and a torch attached to a fuel hose are positioned in the center of the room.

12ft+ twisted and bent tubular wax statues clutch the walls and support beams. 3 faintly scratched pairs of "Xs" are spaced across the floor, making an obtuse triangle across the bunker. Each "X" pair has an "X" against the wall and another .5m inward. Standing on a large X and looking at a mirror's reflection placed on its respective small "x" reveals 1 of 3 distinct images formed by wax statues.

1. Imperfect spiral. The left side is sunken to form a rectangular shape. 2. Nonsensical lines 3. The Solano royal family crest of Uruk 1 [45.2].

- 8 2x months of rations. A vibechete and shotgun rest on a table. A blueprint engraving in iridium lays flat against the floor. The thin plate weighs 9lb (10.9 troy pounds). A 594mm x 841mm typographic poster hangs on the wall.
- 3x fully-filled journals are open and jumbled as if thrown against a wall. They are full of revenge poems, notes about the routines of prison guards, power grid estimates, and recreations of turret manuals. (Players can easily link the journal notes and blueprint engraving to the Julip IV Prison Dome.)
- 9 3x days of rations. A collection of modern and victorian styled seats are zip-tied to the South wall as decoration. A detailed list of politicians in the Slant Initiative [11.2] (on Julip IV) including their place of residence and ship identifier. A book labeled "Sincerely, Thoreau" is overly taped to the bottom of a steel table. Notable quotes include, "The best government is that which governs least." "If I knew for certain a man was coming to my house with the conscious design of doing me good, I should run for my life."
- 10 2x weeks of rations. .5-1m diameter largely see-through balls of wrapped wire hang from the ceiling. Shattered mosaiced mirrors are glued to the floor beneath each one. A small inkling slime organism is somehow stuck inside each one. If close up, the organism will flatten like a disc, and the player will see a horrific memory. +2 Stress.

# GAN BATAA

Gan's soft voice contrasts her sporadic movement. She is constantly moving and changing her line of vision to keep track of the goats' actions and mechanical instruments collected on her walls.

Her words slice in playful insults and she banters about seemingly mundane things like patches people wear or imperfections in their posture. She slips these details in while giving straight answers to inquiries.

Despite the abrasiveness in her personality, she is quite charming with an infectious smile.

Operates a farm of transgenic silk-producing sheep on the planet Julip IV [9.1].

- Bison-sized sheep have been transferred a bovine-Pit-1 gene and either a spidroin or spidroina gene into their cell regulation system for milk proteins.
- The sheep are mild-mannered and eat genetically modified grass and herbs with extreme levels of vitamin D, A, and Biotin for healthy living and superior silk production.
- Four sheep are smaller than the rest, have a bushier coat, and are much more interested in people. They make milk.

The horseshoe shaped barn houses the milking machines, processors, and automatic looms. Threads of silk are twisted from small strands distilled from the milk. It's then passed through the loom and braided into 4-inch thick cords, wrapped in figure eights, and hung neatly on a clothesline. They are then passed through a second loom that weaves the silk into yards of fabric in turn wrapped into bolts.

Gan comes from a lineage of farmers, although her sisters and father raise animals to slaughter. Her family farm kept many pet animals, including the standout personalities of the oxen they sold to butchers. She was taught the importance of love for living things alongside the purpose meat-providing animals serve for intellectual beings. She likes to share her knowledge of healthy diets and the importance of eating animals.

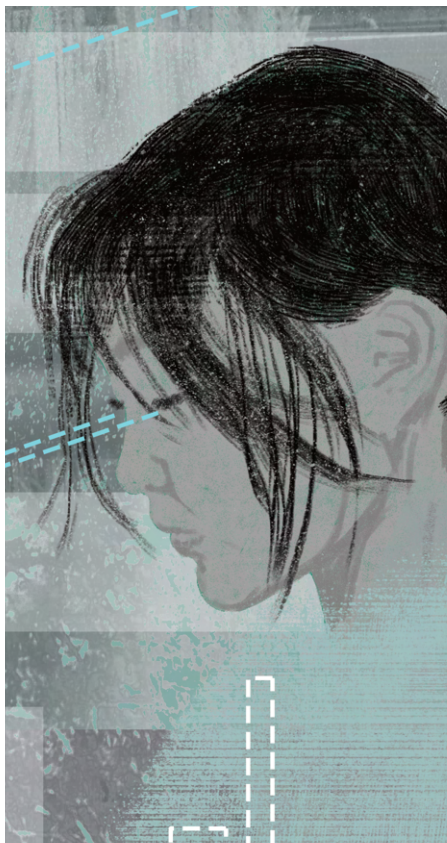

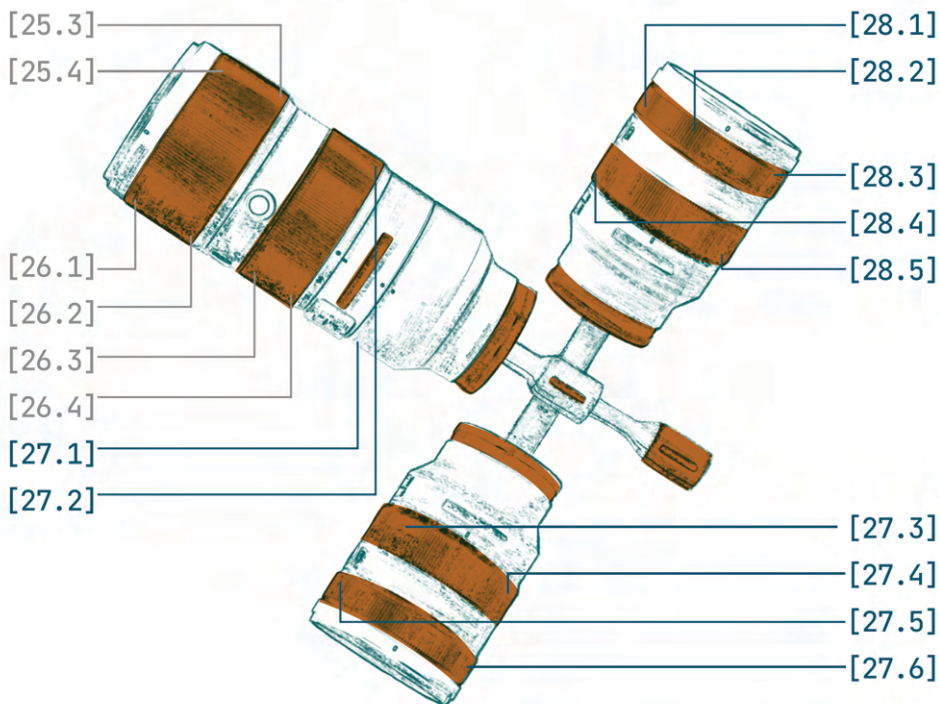

Juxtaposed is the layout of her small studio, pristinely arranged like a miniature museum.

Her tools are kept away in silver tool cabinets, the xenotech displayed on ornate pedestals.

The entire studio is set up with visual flavor while being optimized for work.

All of this fitted inside a smaller Studio [26.1] on the commercial space station Gilgamesh Red [25.1].

- Ainsley comes off cold because of her shyness. She often hesitates to greet people with more than a word as she is distracted by the technology in front of her.
- She warms up quickly with people who speak a lot. If people are bashful it is difficult for her to feel comfortable, providing detailed answers or asking return questions.
- All of this aside if the players are presenting a xenotech artifact. Ainsley can't help but ask about the details of where it was found and what else was found around it.

# MARCELLO RENIATO

[35.1]

Marcello is very particular about being called a Numismatist (noo-miz-ma-tuhst) and will take his time pronouncing it for players. He becomes visibly irritated when called a coin trader.

- Marcello is otherwise composed and speaks slowly as he enunciates. When speaking about coins, his pitch is elevated, often cracking slightly in excitement.

He is outwardly excited when meeting travelers, especially those who have tales of odd encounters. Coins carry stories in their imperfections. What a coin has "witnessed" is almost as important as its origin.

- He will offer an advance (2d100cr) if players keep an eye out for coins during their travels.

- Before becoming a full-time numismatist, Marcello worked for Laughing Sphinx Corporation, a space debris cleanup company. He refers to it as his past life. He loved the work and speaks highly of the importance of removing space debris.

- His Coin Corner [26.3] on Gilgamesh Red [25.1] but commutes once a week from Atlas Roe [12.1].

Coins in space undergo incredible alterations.

- Space corrosion is highly variable depending on the metals. Gold and platinum display high resistance. Aluminum and stainless steel do not corrode. Opposite, silver has almost no protection from its silver oxide layer, flaking easily and producing potentially dangerous space debris. No corrosion occurs in deep space.
- One rarity happens when coins are miraculously fused together in space by cold-welding. When two metal surfaces without an oxide layer touch together in space, they bond permanently as the atoms of either side collapse into each other.
- Coins from certain planets are layered in contaminants from the outgassing of volatile silicones and atomic oxygen bombardment in low planetary orbits.
- Sputtering may be the most exciting. Microscopic particles are ejected from the surface of the coins caused by fast-moving atoms and micrometeoroids.

Kurt's broad shoulders and larger arms demand careful movement through his 5m x 5m storage unit. He hulks over most artifacts he inspects.

Tall metal three-tier shelves are packed with bronze and ceramic oddities. Most of the objects look as historic as they do cartoonish. The detail and craftsmanship of the objects is regal and highly detailed. An uncommon sight on any space station.

Kurt has built his reputation in archeology for decades. He is known as a reliable source of safely procured and gently-treated artifacts from many solar systems.

He privatized his business and moved permanently to Gilgamesh Red [25.1] six years ago. The move was welcomed by the community and quickly garnered support. Pop-up exhibitions, curated out of his Storage Unit [27.4] started becoming popular, eventually leading to requests from individuals, corporations, and governing bodies.

Since going private, his work has been instrumental in proliferating the knowledge of several extinct civilizations.

- Recently, and more controversially, Kurt began curating space horror remnant exhibitions for private investors.
- This strays from traditional artifact collections because these horror anomalies have only been found in recent centuries and there are not many trustworthy professionals in the space horror remains field.
- Kurt is actively looking to extend his network of reliable space horror remnant couriers, exhibitors, and field collectors.
- Many politicians and activists attempt to shut down the private trading of space horror remnants with the belief that they should be held in possession of governments or vetted NGOs for intensive study and development of applications to reduce space horror threats. This has created a chasm between Kurt's supporters.

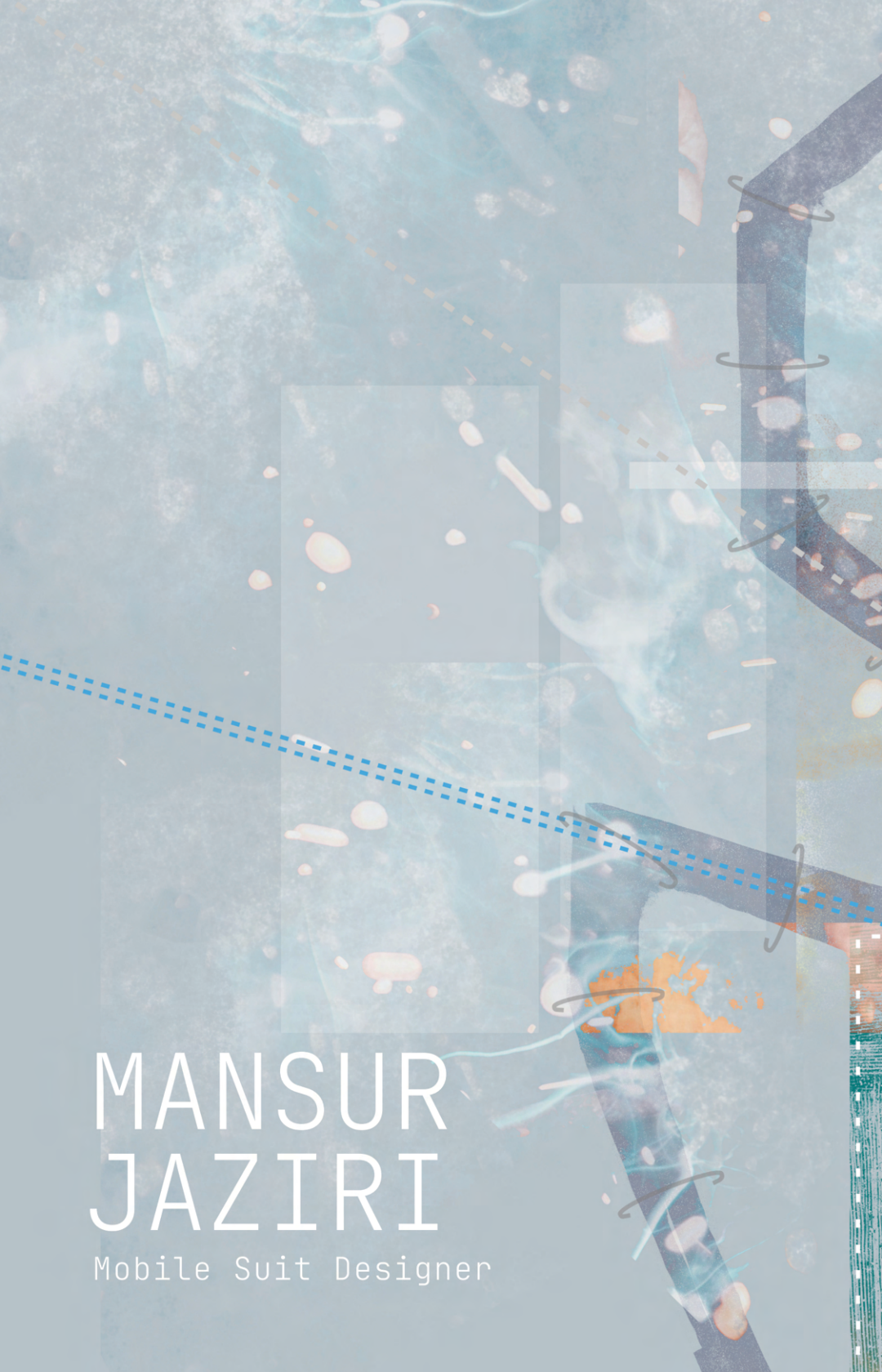

Heavily modded with cybernetics, Mansur sports six mechanized legs that clatter as they imitate an ant's movement. His back is equipped with four additional arms that sprout over his head as he works with heavy metals in extreme heat.

He is jovial in conversation, although rushed. He speaks in close proximity to others and wraps his hand around people during conversation. His love language is touch and places his hand out for soft touches often.

Mansur values his word and keeps confidential information to himself. That sometimes conflicts with his urge to share his excitements and accomplishments.

He can be a bit too concerned with status and evaluating others based on their achievements as he is less interested in spending his time with those who lack stories or connections.

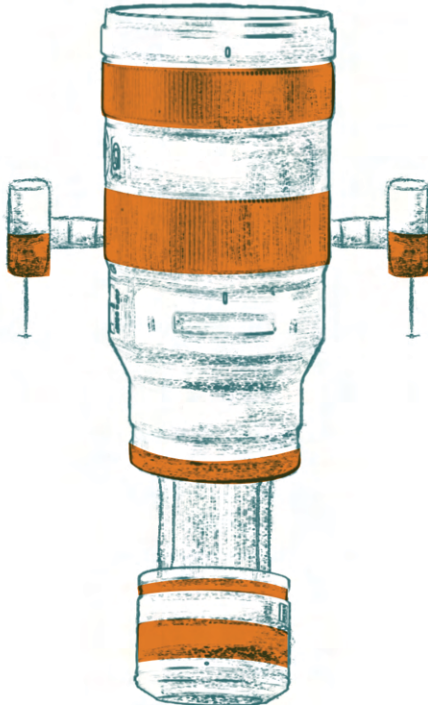
# ADDENDUM

## URUK I

45.2

- Uruk 1 houses the mixed government responsible for all of Julip IV's Satellites [12.1], [25.1]. The station arrived in the orbit of Julip IV during the first years of settlement where the fleeing Solano royal family graciously offered the Julip IV settlement, who had no military presence, a mixed governance agreement.
- The agreement included political autonomy on Julip IV [9.1], and shared governance over its satellites.
- The mixed government splits powers between the Solano royal family, aristocracy, and democratically elected politicians. It features a rotating aristocratic board determined by a calculated influence that comprises wealth, business practices, and public servitude.
- It is the smallest and most protected satellite of Julip IV. Visitation is restricted and only available to political ambassadors or by a request process for all citizens.



## IMAGINARIA

- The **bioterrorist group** is known to be unconventional and unpunctual. This is often forgiven as Imaginaria is the **most reliable space horror dealer**. They are capable of extracting most small to medium-sized horrors and often carry inventory.

## GREY TERROR CARTEL

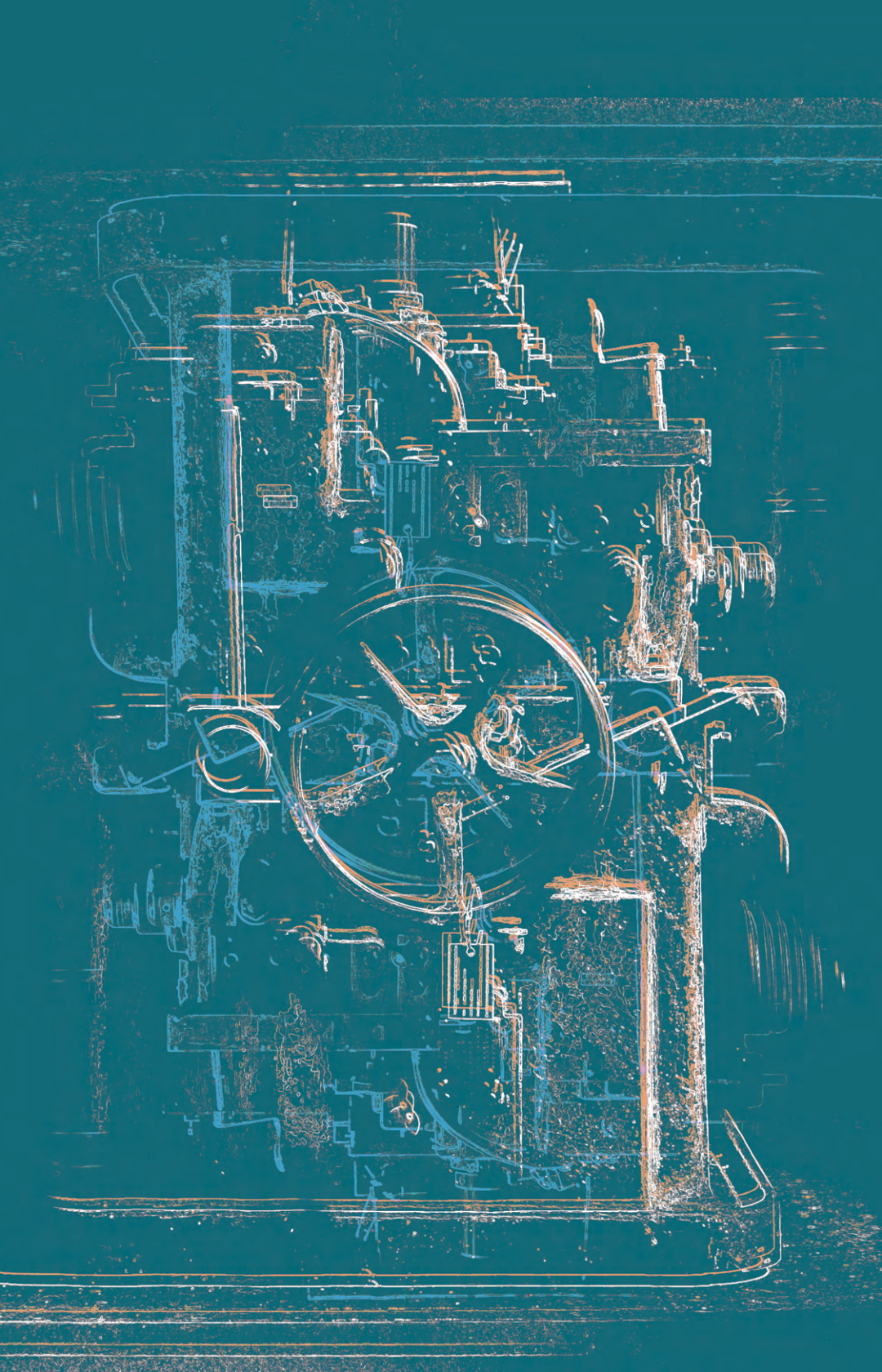

They were **unexpectedly taken down 6 years ago by a hacker group called The Spark, led by the hacker Red Bird (Now known as Zoya Amari [23.1])**. The hackers overtook their ships, opened their airlocks and crashed the ships into each other.

## IRON TIGER

46.3

- The **most notorious vigilante hacker group in the sector**. Collectively, the **loosely tied-together group** has been responsible for overthrowing dictatorial governments, stealing the assets of corporations guilty of heinous human rights violations, and hacking and gaining control of entire battle cruisers on their way to decimate populations.
- They are **mostly seen as good actors, but there are several "out of character" instances that are tied to their name**. These affiliations are often exonerated by the group when they are able to dox the bad actors.
- Iron Tiger was **founded 32 years ago as part of a coordinated black market drug trafficking initiative** to proliferate interplanetary hallucinogenic drugs across as many populations as possible. 2 years later and after several meetings in the group, self-named **"The Overseers"**, **doxed 86% of the hackers in what was later named "The Reboot"**. Under the new **"leadership"** Iron Tiger helped local enforcement bring in hundreds of drug traffickers and began expanding their numbers and targets beyond drug trafficking.



# WARDENS GUIDE TO [48.1] REPAIRING XENOTECH ARTIFACTS

This guide is for wardens who wish to be more granular with restoring xenotech artifacts. For standard skill bonuses we would recommend the existing skills Mechanical Repair, Robotics, and Engineering while including the new Ancient Alien Tech and Xenotech Restoration skills. Alternatively, using this guide may provide more collaboration opportunities for the crew.

**Main note:** PCs generally won't know exactly what ancient technology does. They will either have to randomly test it, utilize collective skills, or find appropriate experts in order to discover what it is capable of, how to charge or fix it, and how to use it.

**Time requirement:** Regardless of skills, ancient xenotech is too diverse to guarantee a quick fix. We recommend 1-3d10 hours of dedicated work depending on the complexity of the tech. Ancient jump drives may require 3d10 hours of dedicated work to fix while xenotech cybernetics that use more familiar technology might require 1d10 hours to fix. Failed rolls may take less time as the failure malfunction may happen at any time during the restoration process.

Take into consideration the type of technology players are interacting with. Some player skills may give situational Advantage [+] to a repairing stat check.

Players restoring tech together may combine skills for Advantage [+] as well.

- **Example 1:** An artifact that interacts with the brain and intelligence may be easier for a player with the Psychology Skill to understand because they would be familiar with available technology in the field.
- **Example 2:** An artifact that is making people sick may be easier for a player with the Pathology Skill to identify how it is transferring the disease.
- **Example 3:** A player with the Sophonotology skill may help an Engineer restore xenotech designed for the biology of an alien sophont.
- In these examples, the players may gain situational Advantage [+] in discovering how to disable, enable, or repair the artifacts.
